
Community Action Plan Review 2022

Introduction

The Community Action Plan was developed by Strathaven and Glassford Community Council (SGCC) following extensive community consultation in 2018. This included full consultation within Strathaven Academy and across all households in both Strathaven and Glassford. The plan was finally launched in May 2019 and has been operational since then to support applications to the Kype Muir Community fund. Development of the Community Action Plan was funded by Banks Renewables.

Review

We are undertaking the review to ensure that the Community Action Plan (CAP) remains relevant for the period 2021 – 2024. Strathaven and Glassford have both grown in population over the last three years and projects have been completed that formed part of the CAP. Priorities may have changed in terms of how the community sees projects being undertaken and there may even have been new priorities identified because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Headings

In the community consultation undertaken in 2018 questions were asked under five headings – Infrastructure, Youth Development, Community Groups, Arts and Sports, Heritage and Culture. For the purpose of this review we will retain those headings.

Infrastructure

This heading refers to projects and initiatives relating to buildings, statues, signs and signposts within Strathaven and Glassford. Many potential projects relate to improvements to existing infrastructure although the Action Plan will not relate to anything belonging to or supported by private companies or the public sector. For example, a project may be identified to improve the bandstand in the park, install a clock in the town centre, or erect a memorial to a famous Stravonian.
